

More funds approved for Rock Creek restoration

The board of supervisors has agreed to pump more money into the Rock Creek restoration plan in North Auburn.

At its recent North Lake Tahoe meeting, the board amended the county's contract with Foothill Associates to the tune of \$39,646, bringing the contract's total cost to \$116,639.

The consulting firm is developing what county planners call "a comprehensive approach to enhancing the Rock Creek tributary between ARD's Regional Park, residential areas to the north, and the commercial center at Bell Road and Highway 49."

The planners added that the Rock Creek work will be a key part of the county's upcoming habitat conservation plan.
